

William Olde (son of Richard) married Anne (Eleanor Courtenay) and then traveled to Sherbourne County, Dorset--where he got into trouble for harboring a Jesuit priest. His house appears to have been ransacked. The Priest Father Edward found hidden in a large oak chest under a curtain. This William Olde was not a rich man and considerable pressure was put upon him by the Protestant Party. In 1566 Oct. 20, he was baptized at Sherbourne Church, according to the rites of the Church of England but after this date we find him paying fines for not attending the Anglican Church and his wife was fined heavily for "Continually and persistently going to sleep during the learned discourses of the Worthy Vicar. About this period the persecution of the Roman Catholics became so strong that, whatever their private belief, they were compelled to outwardly conform to the forms and ceremonies of the Church of England.

Robert Ould (Old) son of John Olde and — Gatherset of Sherborne Co, Dorset, England, was born at Sherborne in 1645, . Emigrated to America, date unknown. First discovered at Windsor, Conn. in 1667.. Apprenticed to Jacob Drake. Married there Dec. 31, 1669 to Susannah Hanford. (She died Jan. 6, 1688). Moved to Suffield, Conn. 1673.. Married there April 1, 1689 to Dorothy Granger (She died 1728). Dau of Lancelot --b--1620--m--Joanna Adams 1654--d-- Sept. 3, 1689.

In 1670 Dr. Robert Ould was granted 50 acres, corner of High St. and New Haven Road in Suffield. The old cemetery adjoins the N.E. Corner. He was one of the first five proprietors of Suffield, was a prominent man in the young town and first to have the title of Doctor, was agent for the town at General Court (Legislature) in Boston 1694 making two trips to Boston and receiving for expenses for himself and horse

pounds 5-15-0. The service rendered were valuable. The town was poor and unable to pay the Colonial Taxes, which amounted to the great sum of pounds 228-4-9. By his effort these were "rebataged", "remitteed and Forgiven by the General Court. The land he dwelled upon can be traced from the Records. A highway "Old Street" long bore the name in the records. He died at Suffield, January 16, 1727.

Robert Olde himself died January 16, 1728. A small slab in the old church yard marks his burial place. From whence he came to Windsor or who his ancestors is unknown. The addition of the letter (s) to the surname is late date in Suffield records. In 1696 a Goodman Old made brick and built the chimney for the ministers house. In 1694 he was appointed town agent to manage their case before the General Assembly in regard to their rates which were burdensome.

Several of his sons remained in Suffield and had families. His sons Jonathon and Robert Jr. had lands allotted them in Springfield west of the River in 1720 and lived there at that time. He was not qualified to vote at the first town meeting and probably was never made a "Freeman".
